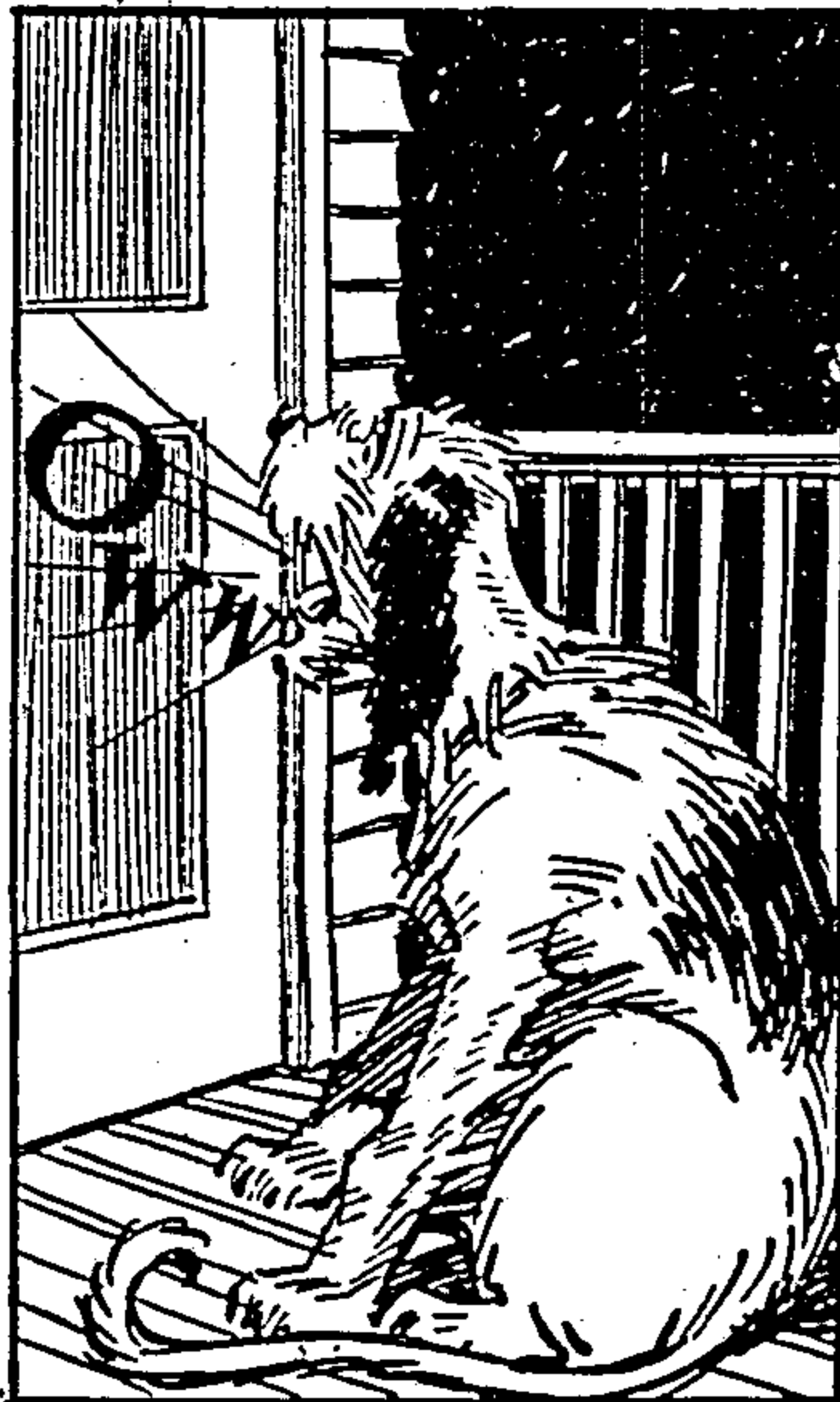


I forgot to tell you—that's UNCLE ELBY with the umbrella in the first picture. When he gets the dog turned around I'll introduce you to NAPOLEON.
